Brittan School has been working diligently to prepare for the 2020/21 school year. There is no one-size-fits-all solution to COVID-19 as it applies to reopening schools. The protocols and policies that we are basing our decisions on are aligned with requirements outlined by our state officials, mandates from the California Department of Public Health and the California Department of Education, and are continually subject to change as information is updated.

Due to circumstances beyond our control, Brittan School will begin the 20/21 school year with Distance Learning instruction in place. After much consideration, the district has determined that Brittan School will remain in a Distance Learning format from August 17th -November 13th. This decision was made in part so that families would have the ability to plan ahead and make necessary adjustments as needed. The first day of school will be Monday, August 17th.
